POLICY OF ELECTIONS

The annual elections are to be held in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Cross Hollow Hills Community Association.

Election of trustees to fill any vacancies will be conducted as prescribed by the By-Laws of the Association.

Nominations for trustees will be accepted prior to and at the meeting. All interested candidates should prepare written statements introducing themselves and briefly outlining their background and qualifications. Candidates should be present at the meeting to respond to any questions or comments from the members.

PROCEDURE

- 1. NOMINATIONS MADE AND SECONDED.
- EACH NOMINEE WILL GIVE A BRIEF STATEMENT.
- 3. QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS FROM MEMBERS.
- 4. NO VOTING WILL TAKE PLACE AT MEETING.
- 5. BALLOTS WILL BE SENT TO ALL LOT OWNERS, WITH ACCOMPANYING NOMINEE STATEMENTS. TWO ENVELOPES WILL BE SENT ALONG WITH WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS TO ENSURE THE PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF EACH LOT OWNER'S VOTE.
- 6. IN THE EVENT THAT THE NUMBER OF NOMINEES IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS OPEN FOR ELECTION, THE BOARD CAN ACCEPT A MOTION FROM THE FLOOR TO CLOSE NOMINATIONS. THE NOMINEES CAN THEN BE ELECTED BY ACCLIMATION.
